The Peoria Symphony Orchestra (PSO) Music Director, George Stelluto, has accepted the challenge from the Peoria Riverfront Museum to cool down for a good cause. The Riverfront Museum challenged the Peoria Symphony Orchestra, the Peoria Civic Center Theater and the Peoria Park District.

Maestro Stelluto, Music Director for the PSO will be taking the Ice Bucket Challenge to bring awareness and support the cause of ALS commonly referred to as Lou Gehrig's disease.
