



2020 YOUNG ARTIST COMPETITION RULES

Saturday, February 29, 2020

8:00 AM – 4:00 PM

ELIGIBILITY

- Applicants must live and attend school within a 100-mile radius of Peoria, Illinois; applicants must also be pursuing a regular schedule of music lessons with a private teacher.
- Contestant must be a student in grades 7 – 12 as of the date of the Young Artist Competition (YAC)
- Previous 1st place winners may compete again, but cannot compete using the same instrument that they placed with during their winning year(s).

APPLICATION PROCESS

- The application, along with a non-refundable \$40 fee, must be submitted by Thursday, January 2, 2020 (make checks payable to: Peoria Symphony Guild)
- The musical selection must be a standard orchestral piece, with instrument or vocal solos. Find the approved repertoire list online at peoriasymphony.org/yac. Other repertoire is subject to approval.
- Voice applicants must be at least 14 years of age or exhibit a mature tone
- Applicants will be notified of their acceptance into the Competition
- The musical selection must be a minimum of 6 minutes, and a maximum of 9 minutes
- Contestants will be required to perform from memory

COMPETITION

- The preliminary rounds of the YAC takes place the morning of Saturday, February 29, 2020 with final rounds in the afternoon. Applicants will receive instructions by mail regarding their assigned practice and competition times.
- Piano students will be admitted early the day of the competition to practice on the stage piano. A practice time must be scheduled in advance with the YAC coordinator, and the student must not exceed the allotted time.
- Contestants must provide three copies of the musical selection to the judges at the audition, one of which must be the original. A piano score is preferred.
- Accompanists must be provided by the contestants.
- No videotaping, photography, or cell phone usage will be allowed within the hall until the winners of the YAC have been announced.
- Only Peoria Symphony Guild members, judges, and accompanists will be permitted (in the hall) during the Preliminary Round.
- The Peoria Symphony Guild will reserve the right, based on the decision of the judges, not to select a winner.
- Written comments of the judges will be provided to each contestant by mail following the YAC.
- All applicants are expected to attend the Final Round of the YAC held in the afternoon.
- Families and the public will be invited to attend the final competition.
- A light lunch will be offered to participating students, their families, accompanists, and teachers between the Preliminary Round and the Final Round of the YAC.

COMPETITION WINNERS

- 1st place - \$500, 2nd place - \$250, and 3rd place - \$100. These awards are made possible by the Donna Wilkinson Schwindenhammer Trust and the Peoria Symphony Guild.
- The winner will perform one selection with the Peoria Symphony Orchestra at the PSO Student Concert on Friday, May 1, 2020 at 10:00 AM and 11:45 AM in the Peoria Civic Center Theater.
- The winner performs at the Peoria Symphony Guild Spring Luncheon, 11:30 AM, May 5th, 2020, at the Country Club of Peoria.
