7-9 concerts per season- Approximately one concert per month September through May

Job Summary: Stage Crew members handle the physical and logistical elements of performances and rehearsals of the Peoria Symphony Orchestra as directed by the Stage Manager.

Duties: Subject to change, duties may include but are not limited to:

- Work all rehearsals and concerts; responsible for transportation, set up and break down of equipment needed for rehearsals and concerts as directed by the Stage Manager
- Be familiar with storage and maintenance of Peoria Symphony equipment and instrument inventory.
- Coordinate rental of truck and transportation of equipment and instruments as needed.
- Physically set up and break down all equipment for rehearsals and performances.
- Ensure appropriate safety measures are in place prior to the start of rehearsals or performances including riser safety rails, handrails, steps, and sound shields as appropriate to venue.
- Coordinate entrances of concertmaster, conductor, guest artists as needed
- Other duties as assigned

Requirements:

- Experience working backstage
- Knowledge of and/or willingness to learn about orchestra music as an art form
- Must be able to lift and carry up to 50 pounds when transporting and setting equipment.
- A valid driver’s license and a safe driving record. Will need to rent and drive truck to transport equipment.
- Must present a professional appearance when on stage.
- Show proof of vaccination with one of the COVID-19 vaccines.
