For 70 years, central Illinois school children from the third to twelfth grades have taken a field trip to the Guild-sponsored Annual Student Concert to experience a live, interactive one-hour performance of the Peoria Symphony Orchestra. Beyond important exposure to live classical music, this field trip offers the opportunity for teachers to create a lesson based on the music and about the featured artists, Louis Lohraseb, conductor, and Erica Petrocelli, soprano.
